Key Stage 1 Playground

The children in Key Stage 1 are really enjoying their new playground. Over the Easter holidays we extended the playground slightly and installed new equipment to create a fabulous outdoor space for the children to exercise and play freely. The playground includes a new trim trail combination and an exciting castle that liberates the children's imagination and stimulates their creativity. The equipment will help the children develop their balance, upper and lower body strength, hand strength, core stability, task and gross motor skills development. As well as physical development the new equipment promotes teamwork and encourages the children to cooperative with each other when coming new challenges.

This new playground was made possible by a large donation from the PTFA, Lottery Funding and the School. We would like to say to a big "thank you" to all parents, friends and staff who not only host enjoyable events for the children but work hard to raise money for valuable resources.















Balanceability

Learning to ride a bicycle is one of life's milestones and we are excited to announce that we have invested in 20 new balanceability bikes for our Key Stage 1 children. Balanceability is a learn to "cycle" programme and through the use of pedal-less bikes, we are teaching the children the balance skills required to learn to ride a pedal bike and eradicate the need for stabilisers. Through a fun and safe introduction to riding a bike we aim to encourage our young children that cycling and keeping active is a part of life!







Bikeability for our Year 5s

Moving on from Balanceability, our Year 5 pupils will be involved in their Bikeability training next week, starting Tuesday 8^{th} May. An email and letter has been sent out detailing which group your child is in and which days your child is attending their course.

The children do not need to wear uniform on the days they are doing Bikeability and they will be allowed to keep their bikes at school overnight in the school hall. It is a fantastic experience for all the children to take part in.
